Animal

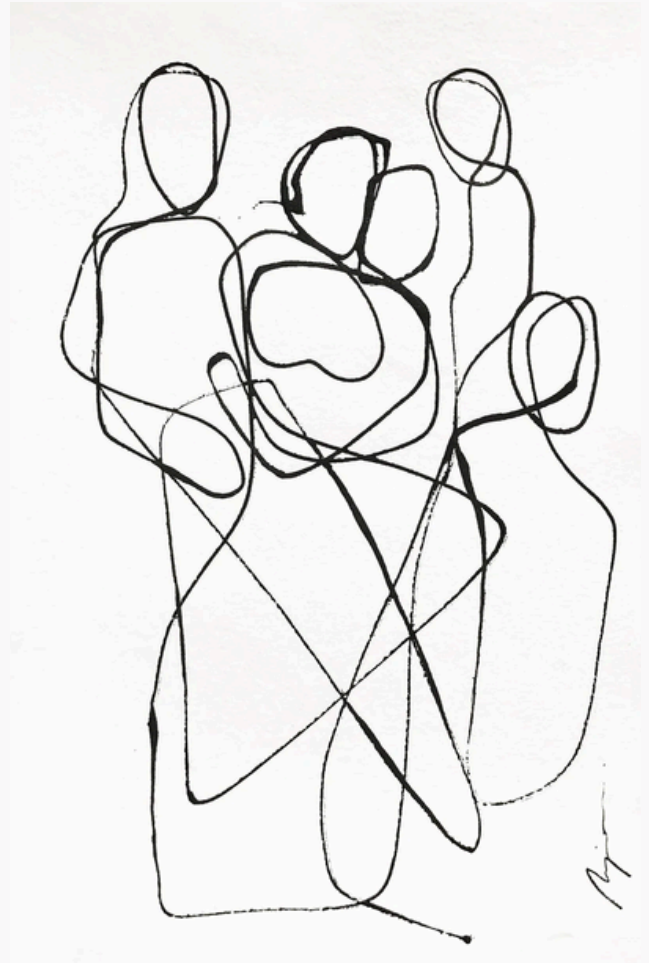
If you steal my courage,
